“On Meeting Human Need”

Christianity has at times been presented as if it concerned nothing but the salvation of souls. Communism in particular criticized the church for not caring for anything else. This may be true in some instances but it certainly was not true with the work of Jesus Christ. He was concerned with the whole person, body, soul and mind.

In the gospel of Luke, Jesus spent His whole day teaching a large crowd spiritual truths. Then He shifted to their need for food for the body. He fed them. He also healed the bodies of the sick. When their hearts were broken, He comforted them. When they were lonely, he invited them to be with Him. He called upon His disciples to do the same as He calls upon us today. Many Catholics have responded by opening up hospitals. Christians across the board have tried to help out the needy.

The first thing necessary is to resist the urge to dodge our responsibility. The first disciples wanted to send the people away, to take care of themselves. Jesus didn't do that. The problems of our world are our problems too. We can't solve all the problems but we can be part of the solution. Better laws need to be addressed in order to help the sick, the homeless, the immigrants, the starving people.

The next step is to take stock of our resources. The disciples did that. They discovered that they had five loaves and two fish. At least they could share these things even though it wasn't enough. We'll discover that we don't have enough to meet total need but we do have something to offer: money, food, friendship, talent and perhaps something else. We can share these things.

The third thing is to work together with other people. The disciples got the people to sit down so that it was easier to serve them. We need to work together with other organizations, with other churches as we are doing for the block party. Together we can reach out to more people.

Another thing is to use the talent God has given us. An encouraging word, a warm smile, an hour of your time could make a tremendous difference in someone's life. One day at Sam's parking lot, I put away a cart a lady had used. Afterwards she said to me "she had been having a horrible day but that minute of kindness made her day."

Finally we can depend on the Lord to make the difference. The disciples fed thousands of people with the Lord's help. The Lord is interested in our needs. Trust Him to supply the rest that we don't have.

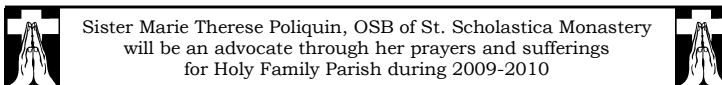
As the Rhubarb Festival quickly approaches, JUNE 26th, there are a few things we need as soon as possible!
